AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

Students will submit video auditions through a Google Form that can be found on the ACT website. In the video, the student should state their name, grade, and the title of their audition piece. The student can then perform 30-45 seconds of any song which shows vocal range and character. We want to see their ability to act and create a character, not just sing! All video submissions are due by 5:00 pm on Saturday, January 30th.

COVID PRECAUTIONS

Throughout the rehearsal and performance process, the ACT will adhere to all CDC guidelines regarding facial coverings and social distancing. Any actors experiencing COVID-like symptoms are asked to stay home. Rehearsals will be held outdoors, weather permitting, as will all four performances. In the event that JTF is cancelled due to COVID-19, any individual funds raised by students for the festival may be credited toward a future ACT camp or student production.
